Coaches: If you (or your representative) orders for your whole team, the entire order will be packaged together and set aside for pick-up alphabetically under the name of the person ordering and paying for the clothing.

If you have your athletes order individually, each order will be paid by that individual and set aside alphabetically. Each individual will need to personally pick up their own order.

Feel free to share the website information with parents and other interested people so they can pre-order as well. Again, each order will be alphabetical by the person completing and paying for the order.

NOTE: Tax will be charged for Online Orders:

\$10 item = \$.55 Tax

\$15 item = \$.83 Tax

\$20 item = \$1.10 Tax

\$30 item = \$1.65 Tax

#### Advantages of Pre-Ordering:

- You get the exact color and size of clothing you want.
- A wider range of clothing sizes are available.
- Some items may be available online that will not be available at the meet.
- No more coming to the meet and finding what you want is already sold out.
- Even if you or your athletes can't be at the meet, you can order and have the clothing shipped to you.

Give the web address for ordering to your athletes (competing or not), parents and anyone else interested. Orders will be alphabetical when picked up. They will have a choice to have their order ready for pick-up on Friday at Lincoln High School, Saturday at the meet (Ridges), or delivered to their home.

Also, as in the past, clothing will be available for purchase from **5PM to 7PM Friday** at Lincoln High School and **9AM-3:30PM Saturday** at the meet for those not pre-ordering.

### **Bringing a Tent? NO STAKES ALLOWED**

If the tent you bring needs securing due to wind, it must be weighted down. Yes, <u>WEIGHTS ONLY</u>.

If you have <u>NO WEIGHTS</u> and need to secure your tent, then <u>NO TENT.</u>

<u>The "No Stake" policy applies to Meet Management as well.</u> Our T-Shirt Tent, Finish Area/Medical Tent, and Volunteer Tent no longer are staked, but weighted down. Stakes for roping and snow fencing are no longer used. We now use portable barricades and a lot of cones, but no stakes, except for Ridges approved turn flags.

The Ridges has invested a lot to upgrade their irrigation system so please find ways to honor their request. (In 2012, the Ridges upgraded their irrigation system, putting miles of control wires, not far underground.)

It may be a little inconvenient to bring weights (sand bags?) for your tents, but it is mandatory, no exceptions.

- PRICE CHANGE!! For the first time in 16 years the admission price has increased. It is now \$8.00 per person (pre-school free). Please let any spectators you know are coming to the meet.
- Park & Ride for Spectators and FAN BUSES (New in 2018 Fan Buses MUST park at the Lion's Club Shuttle Area). Also check out Parking for Teams On-Site
- Awards Ceremony information related to proper attire and conduct.
  - 1. Athletes are requested to wear their uniforms and/or warm-ups (i.e. caps off, no props allowed)
  - 2. To show respect for all participating teams and individuals, return to your seats after receiving awards and remain in the gymnasium until the conclusion of the ceremony.

# TEAM & INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIERS PARKING at the RIDGES FAN BUSES NEW ADMISSION PRICE SPECTATOR FREE PARK & RIDE

**Admission Price Change:** The admission to the meet has changed to \$8.00 per person (pre-school free). This is the first change to the admission price in sixteen (16) years.

**QUALIFYING TEAMS/INDIVIDUALS:** The school's Admittance/Parking Permit for admission and parking will be given to qualifiers at their Sectional Meet.

#### **Expectations**

This card is NON-TRANSFERABLE and is not to be duplicated. If your team has qualified for State and you will need to travel in two vehicles, please contact the WIAA for more information. Individual qualifiers will receive 1 Parking/Admittance Permit only, no exceptions.

Admittance/Parking Permit will be collected by attendants.

The Parking Passes are for Team and Individual Qualifiers ONLY!

**COACHES**, please HAVE MONEY READY (@\$8/person) for people in your team vehicle WHO EXCEED YOUR ALLOWED WIAA ADMISSIONS.

Again in 2019: FAN BUSES: To have enough parking space for all the team vehicles at the Ridges, FAN BUSES must now park at our LION'S CLUB SHUTTLE SITE where the fans will transfer to the Ridges on our shuttle buses.

NOTE: The Lion's Club parking is very under-utilized so the park and transfer will go quickly. The admission of \$8.00 per person (with pre-school age children admitted free) will be collected at the shuttle drop-off at the Ridges.

**PARK & RIDE FREE:** SPREAD the WORD to spectators about our shuttle bus system & park & ride lots. All spectators will be shuttled free by buses to the 20th Street Entrance. (NOTE: The Lion's Club parking is very underutilized.) Admission is \$8.00 per person with pre-school age children admitted free.

We have 104 teams and 260 individuals competing at State. With cars, vans and buses packed into an already crowded lot, along with the continuing increase in Handicapped parking use, we do not have room for unauthorized vehicles in the lot. Please, use the passes appropriately.
